Highlights Test Ride ⇨ Shanti Stupa ⇨ Leh Palace ⇨ Leh Market

Tashi Delek to Ladakh, you will be meet and greet with our ladakhi representative cum chauffeur and proceeds to your pre-booked hotel. Since Leh is an altitude of 11250 ft. above sea level hence due to high altitude, it is utmost importance that you walk or roam around in the town to avoid the AMS (acute mountain sickness).

Afternoon your machine will be handed over following a brief introduction about the upcoming journey. Now it's time to get familiarized with your Machine (The Royal Enfield) as well as mountain traffic. We will kick off the ride to visit the main attraction of Leh town like Shanti Stupa, Leh Palace and visit the multi-colored Leh Market to purchase some essentials before entering the barren land.

Highlights Khardung la Pass ⇨ Nubra Valley ⇨ Cold Desert

On day 3rd, the dream come true as today we will ride over world highest motor able road to approach Khardung la (5602 m), which has been listed in Guinness Book of World Records (GWR). Experience the 360° view of Himalayan range. After enjoying photography at Khardung la, we will start our ride towards Nubra valley (The land of Mongolian camels). On arrival at the camp check-in. Post refreshment proceeds to the desert, where you can experience the double-humped camel ride or spend quality time 😊 in the heart of cold desert.

Highlights Turtuk (Last village of India) ⇨ The Gateway of Siachen Glacier

After breakfast ride to Turtuk, known as the village divided by two countries borders. This picturesque village is the last major settlement of India before the Line of Control. Turtuk was under Pakistan's control until the 1971 Indo-Pak war where it came under Indian governance. After visiting this hamlet return back to Nubra Valley.

Highlights Diskit Monastery ⇨ Shyok River ⇨ Pangong Lake

Today proceeds towards Pangong Lake, en route visit the biggest statue of Buddha at Diskit. Pangong Lake is the largest salty water lake in Asia. This Lake situated on the Indian-Chinese border (at the height of (4360 m above Sea Level). En route, we will stop at Shyok village for tea break. Lunch at Pangong with breathtaking view of brackish Lake, after refreshment at campsite witness the unforgettable Sun-set view at Pangong Lake.

Highlights Chang la Pass ⇨ Thiksey Monastery

Morning ride towards Pangong Lake side to capture the mesmerizing beauty, breathtaking views of deep brackish lake, Say goodbye to Pangong Lake and ride towards Leh, crossing over the 2nd highest motor-able pass "(Chang la 5360 m)". Stop for lunch at Karu village. Before reaching at Leh town we will take a stop at Thiksey monastery. Reach Leh by evening.

Highlights Taglang la Pass ⇨ More Plain ⇨ Lachung la Pass ⇨ Ghata loops 22 Hair-Pin Bend

A fairytale journey from Leh to Sarchu via crossing over Taglang la (5359 m) which is 3rd highest motor-able pass in the world and more plain a perfect blend of mountain-range-horizon, Lachung La (5065m), Nakee la (4740m) and Ghata loops (22 hair-pin bend would gives breathtaking view of Himalayan mountains). End of the day reach at Sarchu campsite.

Ride from **Sarchu – Manali**

Highlights Baralacha Pass ⇨ Darcha ⇨ Jispa ⇨ Rohtang Atal Tunnel ⇨ Solang Valley

How quickly these 7 days of adventure expedition have passed. On day 8 we will ride towards Manali, crossing over the giant Baralacha Pass (4850 meters). Stop at Darcha for Lunch. Post lunch continue ride to Manali via Atal tunnel going through Pir Panjal mountains range of Himalayas at 10000 ft. above sea level (world longest tunnel >9.5 km< above 3050 mt. altitude). Afternoon reach at Manali

After completing the sensational expedition, evening enjoy the farewell dinner with our cruise where we share the memorable moments of the expedition.





Optional: morning will be free to visit Manali town. Afternoon it's time to say goodbye to mountains state as we will drop you at Manali Volvo bus stand to board the bus to Delhi with unforgettable memories and exciting stories to recount. *Our service concludes here.*
