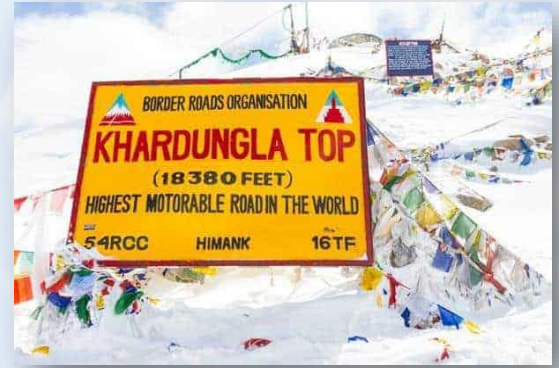



## Highlights Shanti Stupa ⇒ Leh Palace ⇒ Hall of Fame ⇒ Leh Market

Post refreshment proceeds to the desert, where you can experience the double-humped camel ride or spend quality time ☺ in the heart of cold desert.



### **Highlights** Diskit Monastery ⇨ Shyok River ⇨ Pangong Lake

Today proceeds towards Pangong Lake, en route visit the biggest statue of Buddha at Diskit. Pangong Lake is the largest salty water lake in Asia. This Lake situated on the Indian-Chinese border (at the height of (4360 m above Sea Level). En route, we will stop at Shyok village for tea break. Lunch at Pangong with breathtaking view of brackish Lake, after refreshment at campsite witness the unforgettable Sun-set view at Pangong Lake.
